### **About CKC Board Service**

The Board of Directors (<http://centerforknitandcrochet.org/our-team/>) meets once each month via video conferencing. The Executive Committee (comprised of officers) may meet between full board meetings and board members attend other meetings if they are on committees or are working on CKC projects. We are a working board who are performing most of the administrative, operational, and developmental functions of the CKC ourselves, with some committees to support this work. We have no paid staff. Time devoted to the CKC will vary depending upon whether the director also serves as an officer, leads or supports specific projects, or contributes to the CKC's content development on social media. We hope that new directors will be willing to work diligently to support the CKC's growth and development. In general, a board member should expect to devote a minimum of 10 hours per month to the CKC. Director terms are three years and begin immediately upon election to the board. Directors are not compensated, but expenses incurred in board service may be reimbursed by the CKC if the director does not wish to treat them as a donation. Directors must be members of the CKC.
